We are most concerned that an unauthorised access has been created on the eastern boundary of the site, which we have previously reported. We note the comments contained within the flood risk assessment concerning the proposed siting of the pitches but the site itself floods causing additional strain on the emergency services. The design of the ablution block is inappropriate and will cause an unacceptable visual intrusion into the countryside.
